Registered Nurse
Position Description

This position requires a Registered Nurse (RN), currently licensed/registered by the state in which he/she will practice and preferable one year of experience as a professional nurse within the last three (3) years. The RN must be physically capable of performing job-related duties and able to function with minimal supervision. The RN will be required to have a health examination completed prior to accepting assignments and yearly thereafter to verify that the RN is free of communicable disease and physically capable of performing assigned duties.

This position is accountable for providing nursing services in accordance with applicable state licensure status and in compliance with HealthSkil policies and procedures, governmental laws and regulations and applicable health standards.

The RN initiates and/or provides nursing care directed toward preventive, first aid, rehabilitative and supportive care. The RN is responsible for the coordination of assessing, planning, intervention and evaluation of nursing care.

The RN may supervise, instruct and evaluate the performance of other skilled and non-skilled staff. The RN may also participate in utilization review, in-service education and orientation of new employees/contractors as directed by HealthSkil. The RN would incorporate appropriate health teaching, safety precautions, instruction and discharge planning into the health care assignments ascribed.

The RN will maintain confidentiality regarding patients, other health care personnel and documentation. He/she will also act as a resource person to other health care team members in the identification and resolution of client/customer needs.

The RN will prepare and submit accurate and timely documentation in compliance with HealthSkil and government requirements (i.e., nursing notes, time sheets, invoices).

The RN is also responsible for additional duties that may be assigned in response to client and/or office needs.
